

Sasa kurilensis

Origin : Japan

CHARACTERISTICS : Erect, but nevertheless separated enough to allow the foliage to be visualized. Wide, dark green and glossy foliage.

Hardiness : -24°C

Light : Any exposure.

Size : 0,50 to 1,50 m - **Category** : Dwarf

Ø of culms: 1 to 2 mm

Propagation : Rhizome cutting or clump division.

Needs : Grows well in fresh and shady spaces, but sun tolerant. Very difficult to propagate and not suitable for pots cultivation.

Uses : Border, solitary border, undergrowth.

Maintenance : The foliage can be clipped back once a year if necessary to freshen it up.
